

Smoke Free Campus Policy

The Mount Clemens Public Library is committed to providing a healthy environment for patrons and staff who use the library daily. The Mount Clemens Public Library is a Smoke Free Campus beginning February 24th, 2020.

Policy

The policy covers all library property and library owned vehicles. The only excluded areas include:

- Public sidewalks and roadways bordering the library grounds
- Personal vehicles driven or parked on library grounds that have the windows fully closed and where there are no minors in the vehicle.

This policy prohibits the use of all tobacco, nicotine, and marijuana/hemp based products on library grounds, including, but not limited to, cigarettes, vapor cigarettes, cigars, cigarillos, herbs, hookah-smoked products, marijuana/hemp/CBD oils, pipes or any other lighted smoking equipment.

If a violation of this policy is noted, we will request that the person smoking leave the property. Refusal to leave and/or extinguish the prohibited product will result in removal and a possible permanent ban from the library grounds.
